The KSCMP Learning & Development Programme is designed to support multi-agency partners by providing a comprehensive suite of resources and training opportunities. This programme aims to ensure that all staff, including those who are new to their roles, have access to the essential knowledge and skills required for effective safeguarding practice. It encompasses a variety of courses, online modules, and workshops tailored to different professional needs, helping to foster collaboration and shared understanding across agencies.
